The Food Assistance Program (also known as FAP) gives out canned and fresh food items every month at each site listed below. Each household is allowed **one visit per month** to the **location closest to you**.

\*For households with 11 or more persons, add \$478 to monthly income for each person or \$5,730 to the annual income.

#### 2. Please Bring:

- **Valid form of identification:** (Driver's license, birth certificate, I.D. card, etc.)
- **Proof of Address:** (Driver's license, PG&E bill, telephone bill, lease or rent agreement).
- **Valid form of identification for each household member in families of 6 or more:** (MediCal cards, school id, Social Security cards, etc)
- Clients need to verbally verify that their income falls under the guidelines for the program.
