START A FOOD DRIVE

Host a Food Drive at your work, school, congregation or event! The food collected provides a greater variety of groceries for the community members we serve and is a tangible way for donors to visualize their impact.

Are you ready to hold a food drive? Here's what you need to know:

What kind of food is needed?

We recommend donating healthy, nonperishable food that you would like to eat! Here's a list of our most needed items:

- Peanut butter
- Canned tuna and chicken in water
- Shelf stable milk
- Beans and lentils (dry or canned)
- Rice
- Whole grain cereals/crackers
- Whole wheat/grain pasta
- Canned vegetables/soup/tomato products (low sodium and easy open)
- Canned fruit in juice
- 100% fruit juice (cartons or small boxes only)
- Nonperishable, ready-to-eat meals (chili, ravioli, etc.)



Please note: The Food Bank cannot accept glass containers, food one year past its 'best by' date, open or partially-used products, alcohol or food without nutrition labels.

Do not put cash or checks in the collection bins!

What should I use to collect the food?

We recommend using boxes or bags you have on hand to collect and transport food.
