VEGAN COMPANY DONATES 3,000 CASES OF FOOD IN COVID-19 RELIEF EFFORT

Plant-based brand Sophie's Kitchen has donated roughly 3,000 cases of its vegan seafood alternative to Bay Area food shelters in the face of the COVID-19 pandemic.
